## **CURRENT REPORT NO 2/2015**

**Subject:** Notification of sale of shares of the Issuer

The Management Board of FABRYKI MEBLI "FORTE" S.A., with its registered office in Ostrów Mazowiecka, would like to inform that on 5 January 2015 it received the following notification from MetLife PTE S.A. with its registered office in Warsaw:

"In conjunction with Article 69 section 1 of the Act of 29 July 2005 on Public Offering, Conditions Governing the Introduction of Financial Instruments to Organised Trading, and Public Companies (Journal of Laws 05.184.1539, as amended), MetLife PTE S.A. informs that MetLife Otwarty Fundusz Emerytalny [MetLife Open-End Pension Fund] (hereinafter referred to as "OFE") reduced its existing holding by at least 2% of votes in Fabryki Mebli Forte S.A.

The holding was reduced as a result of a sale of company's shares on 22 December 2014. Immediately before the change, OFE held 3,022,474 ordinary bearer shares, i.e. 12.73% of the Company's share capital, entitling to 3,022,474 votes at the General Meeting, i.e. 12.73% of the total number of votes at the Company's General Meeting.

Currently, OFE holds 2,975,474 ordinary bearer shares, i.e. 12.53% of the Company's share capital, entitling to 2,975,474 votes at the General Meeting, i.e. 12.53% of the total number of votes at the Company's General Meeting.

The investment is a portfolio investment. In the perspective of 12 months, the Fund permits a possibility of increasing the number of shares held depending on the development of the market situation and the operations of the Company. The purpose of the acquisition of Company's shares is to invest assets as part of the Fund's investing activities with the aim of achieving the maximum security and profitability of investments. The Fund does not also rule out a sale of shares if their value increases appropriately or any changes occur in the development of the market situation or the operations of the company."
